As an athlete, I will adhere to the following expectations:

- Respect the volunteer referees at all times
- Put the needs of my team in front of my desire to earn personal accolades
- Shake hands with my opponents at the end of each game
- When I'm a spectator, cheer respectfully, honour the referees hard work, and be encouraging at all times

I understand that the following is NOT TOLERATED as a REIL athlete:

- Unsportsmanlike behaviour on the court
- Unsportsmanlike behaviour/disrespectful talk about teammates or opponents before, during, or after games (that means in the hallways and in the classroom as well)
- Unsportsmanlike behaviour/disrespectful talk about volunteer referees before, during, or after games (that means in the hallways and in the classroom as well)
- Not participating in the end of game handshake
- Not helping set up or clean up if I am able
- Elevating yourself above everyone else on your team by being a ball hog or show off

Finally, if I am not able to meet the expectations outlined in this contract, I understand that any teacher volunteer has the authority to remove me from the program for any amount of time, as deemed appropriate by the group of teachers running the program.

3. There aren't any scouts or scholarships on the line
4. While winning a championship is the goal, the person you become in pursuit of that goal, and oftentimes if you fail to meet that goal, is MUCH more important in the long run

I/we understand that the following is NOT TOLERATED by any Parent or spectator:

- Disrespectful and/or accusatory comments towards and/or about any volunteer referee
- Talking disrespectfully to and/or about any athlete involved in the program
- Public displays of physical/verbal aggression and/or accusations about the integrity of the program

As a parent, if I/we are not able to meet the expectations outlined in this contract, I/we will be asked to

leave the gym and there will be an in-game penalty for my/our son/daughter's team.

Finally, if my/our child is not able to meet the expectations outlined in this contract, I/we understand that any teacher volunteer has the authority to remove him/her from the program for any amount of time, as deemed appropriate by the group of teachers running the program.
